**ONLINE CLASS DEFINITION**

An online course will not meet in the classroom. The online class may complete all of its work through the utilization of any combination of the following methods: group websites; group chat rooms; rich media (podcasts; video; audio; slideshows, etc.); email; phone discussions through conference calls; web-based conference meetings; etc. Check with the instructor for details.

**BLENDED CLASS DEFINITION**

A blended class will meet on the campus periodically throughout the semester. The curriculum will be delivered through a combination of on-ground and online experiences. The frequency of the on-ground class meetings will be determined by the instructor in cooperation with the students. The times that are listed on the schedule for class meetings should be set aside throughout the semester for anticipated on-campus class sessions. The online sessions or online group meetings will be scheduled by the instructor. Check with the instructor for details.

**REQUIREMENTS for ONLINE and BLENDED CLASSES**

You will need to have access to the web and email in order to successfully complete an online or blended course. You will also need the ability to send and receive attachments via email. You may also be required to download podcasts, audio files, view video online, or instant message, depending upon the instructor's choice of tools for delivering the curriculum. Check with your instructor for details.

If you sign up for an online or blended class, you must ensure that your email in the Briarwood system is correct. Check with the registrar if you are not certain. Your instructor will email you directions and the syllabus for the class. The syllabus may be posted on a website.

You do not need an email address from the college to enroll in online or blended courses. If you are going to use your private email address, you must ensure that address is part of your school record. See the registrar or your advisor to update and verify your email address of record. The school must have a current email address in order for the instructor to send you materials and information for the online or blended classes.

Online classes require a high amount of self-discipline in order to successfully complete the required tasks. Much of the work involves self-directed scheduling. The convenience of an online or blended course provides an opportunity to work from home or complete assignments during more flexible hours. The coursework is no less vigorous than an on-ground class and may be more intensive for individuals who are less prone to be successful with more self-directed study.
